Reminders for the end of the season.

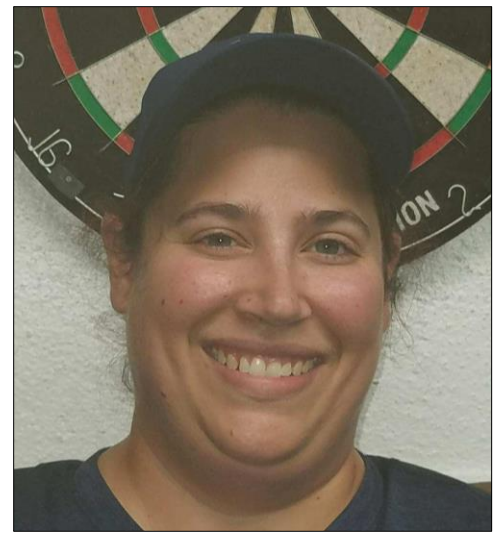
No reschedules permitted during the last three weeks of the season.
